In light of the recent negative, politically-charged events taking place in our country, the men of KLCC Men's Ministry are **praying and taking action!** There is a clarion call from God to be socially responsible and the men of KLCC are not taking a step back, but forward!

On July 13, 2016, **Pastor Henry Wells** invited all of the men of Kingdom Life Christian Church to join in a conference call. The elders, partners and friends of KLCC offered their opinions. There emerged an indisputable fact — that the lives of African American citizens, especially African American men, in this country historically have been discounted and devalued.

Brother Steve Williams, as a law enforcement official, was asked to share his perspective. He provided insight and practical ways that men can handle themselves in confrontational situations and remain safe.

Pastor Wells emphasized the importance for men to be socially responsible. One way, he suggested, is for the men of KLCC to **mentor** young men within our congregation and community.

Indeed, it was a very fruitful 'God-ordained' discussion which concluded in prayer for those affected families, our nation and world!

Intercessory Prayer

Kingdom Life Christian Church has a mandate of prayer that directs and infuses all that we do. We are taught that as Kingdom citizens, we have access to the Most High God. We are able to appropriate the promises that are in the Word. What an awesome privilege!

KLCC is a house that equips and trains believers to be effective and strategic intercessors that are able to strike the mark which is the term *paga*. We learn how to **pray with understanding**--to elicit God's assistance in matters known to us. We are to **pray in the spirit** also which is to pray with the Holy Spirit's assistance. An example of praying in the Spirit is praying in your prayer language. *For if I pray in an unknown tongue, my spirit prayeth, but my understanding is unfruitful* (1 Corinthians 14:14)

We are a House of unity. There is phenomenal power released as we come together and pray.

As a KLCC partner, there are many opportunities to pray corporately. Here are just a few:

1. **Prior to Sunday Service**, you may have noticed people positioned and praying around the sanctuary, lifting up holy hands and asking the Holy Spirit to break forth, and fill the House. We ask God to allow the people to hear the Word free of distractions and receive transformation. Join us as we pray that God moves mightily from praise and Worship, the message, altar call, to dismissal.
2. **Corporate Prayer** Corporate intercessory prayer begins directly before service. Join your faith with the prayer leaders. This is a very crucial time that stills the hand of the enemy and makes the atmosphere conducive for salvation, deliverance and healing!
3. **Prayer Conference Call** is another chance to pray in unity with KLCC. Notification goes out via E-mail with the phone number to dial and the access code. **Pastor Donyale** or the prayer leader directs the prayer as the Holy Spirit leads.
4. **Confessions** Get a copy of the **KLCC Ministry Confessions**. The Bible tells us to not cast away our confession of faith because there is a great recompense of reward. He rewards us with our petitions as we believe and speak His Word aloud.


